	Experience and history	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drug/alcohol use by motorists and pedestrians</li> <li>• Literacy rates of program participants</li> </ul>
Environmental	Support and services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Roadway nighttime lighting, lack of signage and walkways</li> </ul>
	Access, barriers, and opportunities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Land use (commercial complexes located immediately across from residential areas with high-volume multi-lane roads separating them)</li> <li>• Designs (multiple turn lanes and wide vehicle turning radii)</li> <li>• Wide roads (four or more lanes)</li> </ul>
	Policies and living conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enforcement of speed limits in high motor vehicle volume areas</li> </ul>
